All activities in the Community room continuing; Line Dance, Bowls, Tai Chi, Egyptian Dance, Textiles and Sewing Group. Also parties throughout the year. Fundraiser for dementia uk was held.

Submission had been sent to East Suffolk planning dept for new tractor garage. It was decided that a steel building would be a better option than brick built. This project was completed in September and the old container removed.
