Corton Almshouse Charity: -

There have been many repairs to our bungalows this year.

- Four have had new bathrooms
- One new kitchen
- Fire doors and extra smoke alarms in six bungalows
- New windows and doors for four bungalows
- Extra roof insulation, to some of the bungalows to bring the property up to current regulations
- External work on bungalows
- Warden call system upgraded to digital

A wild flower meadow has been planted on a vacant piece of land, which should come into bloom next spring/summer.

At the time of writing, all bungalows are occupied. The Trustees are welcoming two new residents. We have no waiting list for bungalows, we chose the most in need person at the time.

- We have a new chiropodist, who has taken over the list of subsidised foot care.
- The home alarms have now been switched over from analogue to digital.

- New fencing is going up around the allotments with numbering, so plots will be clearly signed.
- All allotments with tenants are being worked on and are looking great.
